

All Saints Hackbridge and Beddington Corner Modern Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

The Parochial Church Council (PCC) of All Saints Hackbridge and Beddington Corner (Registered Charity No 1185029) are the Trustees of the charity and the PCC is committed to ensuring our practices combat slavery and human trafficking. This statement sets out the steps we are taking.

This statement covers All Saints Church, All Saints Centre and all our activities.

All Saints is part of the Diocese of Southwark within the Church of England and the worldwide Anglican Communion.

The PCC operates and has maintenance responsibilities for our church and our community centre. The PCC has the responsibility of cooperating with the Incumbent in promoting in the ecclesiastical parish the whole mission of the church.

The PCC employs a small number of staff (Centre Manager and Centre Assistants)

The PCC has signed up to Reigate Archdeaconry's Social Action Focus pledges on modern slavery and we have committed to doing all in our power to make our church free of modern slavery.

The aim is to eradicate forced labour, modern slavery and human trafficking and secure the prohibition and elimination of the worst forms of child labour.

We have committed to:

- being a Fairtrade church
- using recruitment methods that eliminate the possibility of slavery
- displaying posters in places that our staff, church family members, visitors to our church and users of our Centre will see
- promoting the message of modern slavery in our church and on our website
- providing a modern slavery statement which will be published on our website and other promotional materials.
- encouraging the reporting of signs of modern slavery, intelligence and information to help detect slavery to
